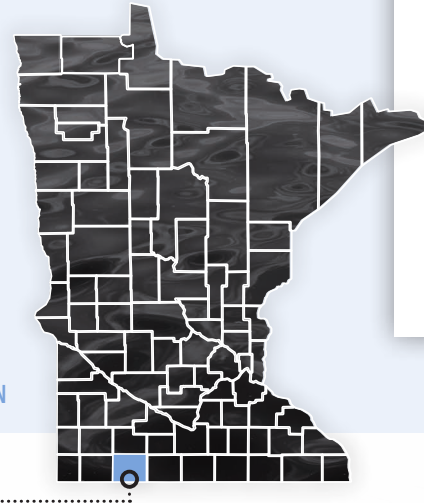


# LOON LAKE IMPROVEMENT: Jackson County Judicial Ditch 8

## CONGRATULATIONS!

Jackson County, Minnesota was awarded a \$390,000 grant from the Minnesota Board of Water and Soil Resources through the Clean Water Fund for Multipurpose Drainage Management. The funding will be used for Best Management Practices, including a 4.6-acre constructed wetland to provide water storage and allow sediment and nutrients to settle out before entering the lake, and installation of 17 Alternative Side Inlets (ASI) for additional water quality benefits.

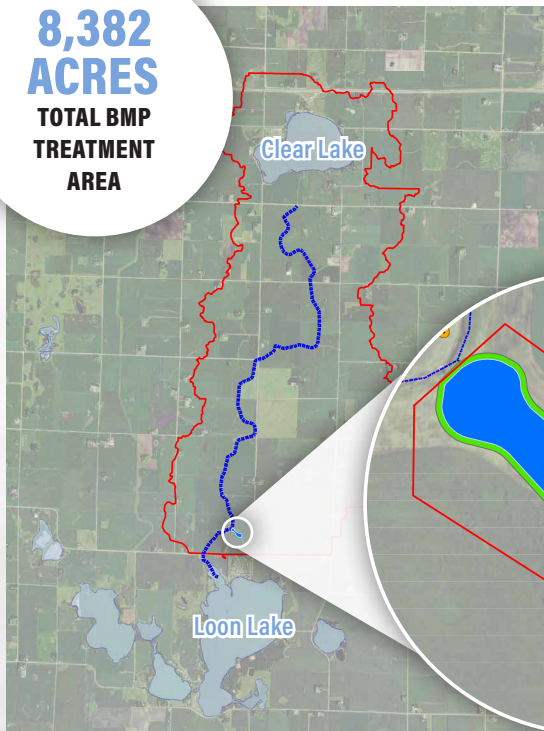


**PROJECT AREA**
